All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Jammu, an Institute of National Importance, is one of the new AIIMS and apex healthcare Institute under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) which has been established by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, with the aim of correcting regional imbalance in quality tertiary level healthcare in the country, and attaining self-sufficiency in graduate, postgraduate and higher medical education and training.

Online applications from Indian citizens/persons registered as Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholder under Section 7A of the Citizenship Act, 1955 as permissible under the applicable Act/Rules are invited for the following faculty posts on contract basis in various departments of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Jammu.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The AIIMS, Vijaypur, Jammu reserves the rights to increase or decrease or not to fill up any post(s) without assigning any reason. The Competent Authority reserves the right to amend, cancel or change this advertisement as a whole or in part without assigning any reason or giving notice.
- 2. Applicants must possess the essential qualification and experience up-to-the last date of online submission of application(s). Their candidature will be cancelled at any stage if it is found that their educational qualification or experiences is/are not genuine.
- 3. **UPPER AGE LIMIT**: 50 years.
- 4. **SELECTION PROCESS**: Selection is based on performance in the Interview. However, written test or screening, based on objective criteria may be done to short list applicants to be called for interview. The decision of the Competent Authority regarding shortlisting of candidates to be called for interview, would be final and binding on all candidates.
- 5. Canvassing of any kind will be a disqualification.
- 6. The candidate should not have been convicted by any Court of Law.
- 7. All disputes will be subject to jurisdiction of Court of Law at Jammu UT of J& K.
- 8. **APPLICATION FEE**: Rs 1000/- (Non-refundable)
- APPLICATION PROCESS: The aspiring applicants satisfying the eligibility criteria in all respects can submit hard copy of application forms to Registrar, Academic Block, AIIMS, Vijaypur, Jammu on or before the last date as mentioned.

10. **ELIGIBILITY NORMS**:

- a) The applicants applying in response to this advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the post applied for. They must be fulfilling eligibility criteria as on the closing date of Online applications i.e. should have passed qualifying exam for essential education qualification / have completed duration of experience as given in Recruitment rules on or before last date of online submission of form. In those cases where one passes exam or complete duration of experience after this date, their candidature will stand cancelled.
- b) Candidates must upload the documents/certificates in support of all the claims made by them in the application like, Date of Birth, Experience (in sequence as mentioned in application), Essential qualification(s), or any other information as applicable in their case, separately against each claim. Each document should be uploaded in PDF format. File size should not exceed the prescribed limit. Print out of all such file should be legible when printouts are taken. For this purpose, the applicant should scan the documents/certificates in 200 dpi grey scale. Documents which have not been asked for like Pay Slip,

- Resume, Appointment letter, Relieving letter, Un-signed Experience Certificate etc. <u>must not be</u> uploaded in Document upload module.
- c) Based on the information provided in the application, candidates are provisionally invited to present themselves in person for the interview without any scrutiny of eligibility. However, on the day of interview, documents to determine eligibility w.r.t. to essential qualification(s), age, experience, as applicable, NOC etc. will be scrutinized by the Institute's scrutiny committee. Only after the satisfaction of Scrutiny Committee w.r.t his/her eligibility, a candidate will be allowed to appear in the interview for the post. Cut-off date to determine the eligibility for all purposes and in all respects is last date of filling up application form. If any ineligibility is detected at any stage, candidature of the candidate will be cancelled without any notice.
- d) Matriculation/10th Standard or equivalent certificate indicating date of birth, or mark sheet of Matriculation/10th Standard or equivalent issued by Central /State Board indicating Date of Birth should be submitted in support of claim of age.
- e) Education Qualification certificates: as per Recruitment Rules for the post applied must be uploaded. In case of those who have equivalent educational qualification, Order/ letter regarding equivalent Educational Qualification claimed, indicating the Authority (with number and date) under which it has been so treated, regarding equivalent clause in Essential Qualifications, if a candidate is claiming a particular qualification as equivalent qualification as per the requirement of advertisement. The equivalent qualification will be decided by the Competent Authority of AIIMS, Jammu and his decision will be final in this regard.
- f) Experience Certificate: should be from the Head(s) of Organization (for the period of experience claimed, clearly showing the, duration of experience ("from" to "to"), Nature of experience (either teaching and/or research). Teaching / research experiences which are gained in organization recognized by MCI/NMC/UGC recognized teaching institutions will only be considered. Experience acquired after having acquired requisite essential qualification for the applied post will only be considered to determine eligibility as per RR for the post.
- g) **DNB equivalence:** In cases of those who are holding DNB in broad specialties or super specialty as essential qualifying education, they have to produce documentary evidence issued by Competent authority about DNB equivalence with MD/MS/DM/M.Ch as per NMC New Delhi notification dated 14.02.2022. (The Diplomat of National Board (DNB) in broad specialty and super specialty qualifications when granted in a medical institution with attached hospital or in a hospital with the strength of **five hundred or more beds**, by the National Board of Examinations, shall be equivalent in all respects to the corresponding broad specialty (MD/MS) and super specialty (DM/MCh) postgraduate qualification, but in all other cases, senior residency in a medical college for an additional period of one year shall be required for such qualification to be equivalent for the purpose of teaching.)
- h) NOC Certificate: No Objection Certificate from the present employer (in case of regular candidates working in Government/Semi or Quasi Government, Government enterprises or Government funded autonomous institutions) is mandatory. Those who fail to produce NOC will not be allowed to appear for the interview for the post. Therefore, candidates are advised to upload NOC along with application or alternatively must produce it at the time of interview failing which he/she shall not be interviewed. Candidates, who are working as contractual employee in Government/Semi-Government/PSUs/Autonomous Bodies or any institution funded by Government, also have to produce NOC mandatorily. In case of change in employment status on or before interview/selection process due to any reasons, they have to take fresh permission from their new employer before interview and they also have to submit fresh NOC from their new employer.

- I) Applications which are not complete as required for online submission, or applications where application fee is not submitted will be rejected without any communication. Therefore, to avoid rejection of their

- application, candidates are requested to make sure that application fee is paid, application is complete in all respect before they finally submit/upload the application.
- m) **PowerPoint Presentation**: Candidates are required to bring a Power Point Presentation of work/major achievements (loaded in own Pen drive containing PPT only), not exceeding five minutes covering the following aspects (05 slides only):
 - a. First Slide: Mentioning only Name and the post applied for
 - b. Second slide: Educational Qualifications (including the year & name of institutes from where he/she has secured the degree).
 - c. Third slide: Working Experience (include the year & name of institutes where he/she has worked
 - d. Fourth Slide: Research/Publications
 - e. Fifth Slide. Major Recognition/Awards/innovations.
- n) Candidates must note that mere appearing in interview does not confer them any right to selection. Candidates have to score minimum qualifying marks in interview as may be fixed by the Selection Committee for empanelment in the order of merit for selection.
- O) Document Verification: All the original certificates/documents will be verified at the time of interview. The short-listed candidate(s) who are called for interview should bring print out of online application, a set of self-attested photocopy of all documents uploaded online along with Original certificates / documents. (i) 10th class, (ii) essential educational qualifications and experience certificate/s. Failure to produce these certificates/documents on the day of verification of documents/interview will lead to cancellation of candidature and candidate will not be allowed to appear for interview.  - iv. Certificate of Registration with Medical/Dental Council of India, whichever is applicable.
 - v. Experience Certificate showing that you have possessed the requisite number of years of teaching and/or research experience on last date of online application, as prescribed for each post, from MCI/other recognized Institution(s) as applicable, subject to following:
 - 1. Teaching/Research experience acquired only after post graduate qualification/Ph.D. as applicable in the specialty will be considered.

- 11. **PAY & ALLOWANCES:** Rs. 1,52,250/- per month (consolidated)
- 12. **JOINING TIME** will be 30 days from the issue of appointment letter. Extension in joining time will be considered, only in exceptional cases, with the approval of Competent Authority, AIIMS, Jammu. If one is selected / offered against more than one post, when he/she joins against offered post & opts to change, he/she will not be allowed to change

- 16. **DISQUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT ON MEDICAL GROUNDS**: Candidate shall be appointed to the Service, only if, after such medical examination, as the Institute may prescribe, he/she is found to be in good mental or bodily health and free from any mental or physical defect likely to interfere with the discharge of the

duties of the Service.

- 17. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT: Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information in filling up the application form and any documents in the recruitment process.
